A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR



Lesley Quinn

One of our most enduring images of England is the quiet, rural village. A place where everyone knows their neighbours, where tea and scones are served at 4 o'clock and sherry at 6; a place where no one needs to lock their doors. It's a place that doesn't exist today, and maybe it never did. Agatha Christie certainly appeared to think it didn't. Her character of Miss Marple, possibly the quintessential English spinster, believes that beneath the quiet calm of village life lies a storm of intrigue. Her knowledge of human nature, drawn from her observations of those around her, give her an insight into criminals that rivals more logical detectives like Sherlock Holmes and Hercule Poirot, and it is for this reason that I am thrilled to be able to bring one of her stories to the stage.

Created at a time of upheaval in Christie's life, Miss Marple represents a point of calm in the tempest of a changing world. She goes along quietly while the world changes around her, and while she longs for the past, she understands that the world must move forward.

Chipping Cleghorn exemplifies that storm. On the surface we have the genteel folk who calmly sip sherry and resent the intrusion of murder into their well-ordered life, but underneath is a swirling vortex of secrets and lies.

The cast and crew have worked incredibly hard over the past few months to bring you this mystery, and I thank them from the bottom of my heart. With my first outing as a director cut unceremoniously short due to COVID-19, I have waited a long four years to present a production of mine to the public, and I couldn't be happier to be bringing it to you tonight.

And now, welcome to Little Paddocks and the world of Miss Marple. Have some tea, gossip with your neighbours, and see if you can solve the mystery because A Murder Is Announced!

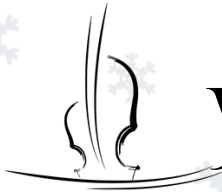

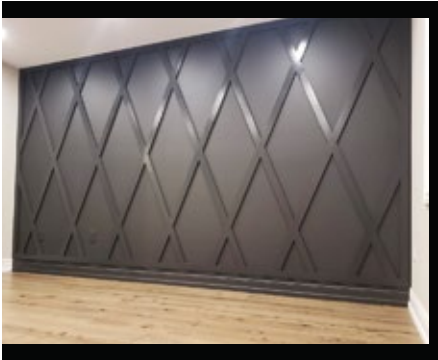

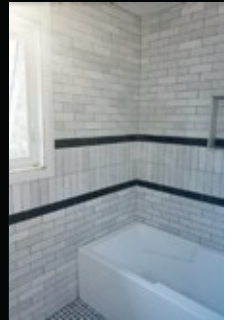

Between 70 and 75 decisions are made within the first 24-48 hours of death. It's difficult to think rationally while making so many decisions within days of losing someone, pre-planning gives yourself, family and friends peace of mind. Pre-planning gives your loved ones direction of your wants and desires.
